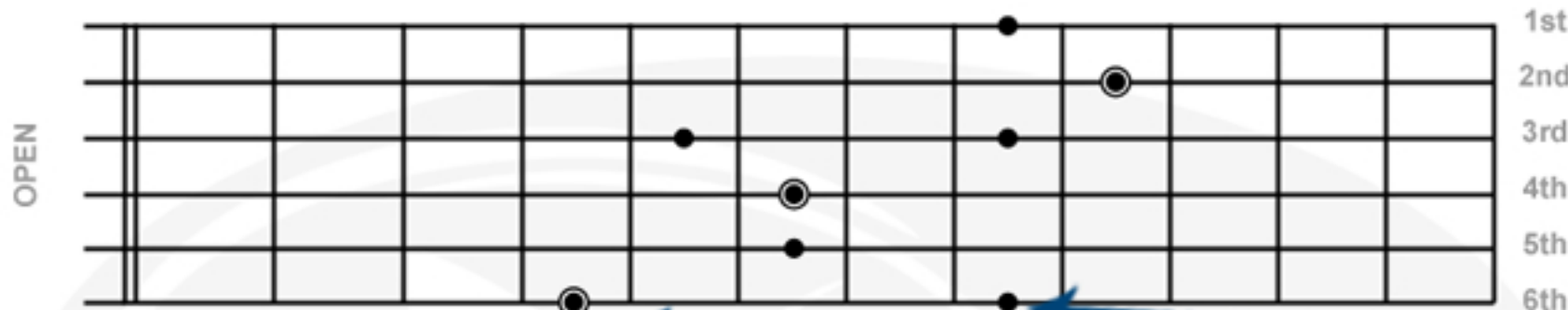


Arpeggio chart help

● = root

Major Arpeggio Pattern #5

1 This is the name of the arpeggio with corresponding pattern number.



2 These are string number indicators, the 1st string is the skinniest string on your guitar and the 6th is the thickest.

3 These solid dots represent a fretted string. You fret a string using your fingers.

C Major Arpeggio Pattern #5

4 These solid dots with a circle around them represent the tonic of the scale.

5 This is the staff with the arpeggio pattern represented in musical notation.

6 This is guitar tabalture with the arpeggio pattern represented by string and fret numbers.

8 This is the key signature that the arpeggio is in, in this example the key is C major.
