A red cross indicates a string that is to be muted and not to be played.

1

An empty circle indicates an open string is to be played.

The name of the chord or voicing number.

The fret number in which the root note is to be played.

A curved line indicates a series of notes are to be played using a barre (barre: a single finger fretting 2 or more notes).

The circled dot indicates the root note of the chord. In this example the root is A.
